None of that happens without donors like you!

The library's tax-funded budget doesn't cover many of its great resources and services. The FOL raises money to fund these "extras" such as museum passes, free SAT prep, citizenship classes and dozens of lectures, concerts and cultural festivals. We underwrite the lending of 100 WiFi hotspots, fund all the tech in the "Lab," including 3D printers and Cricut craft machines, and the Library of Games & Gadgets. (See additional initiatives on reverse side.) In fact, FOL funding more than doubles the library's budget line for all program services each year.

In addition to crucial fundraising, the FOL advocates on library issues and produces its own special programs such as:

- **FOL University** featuring renowned science writer Dava Sobel on November 16, 2025
- **Book & Author Luncheon** on Friday, May 1, 2026
