Breaking Stalin's Nose (2011)

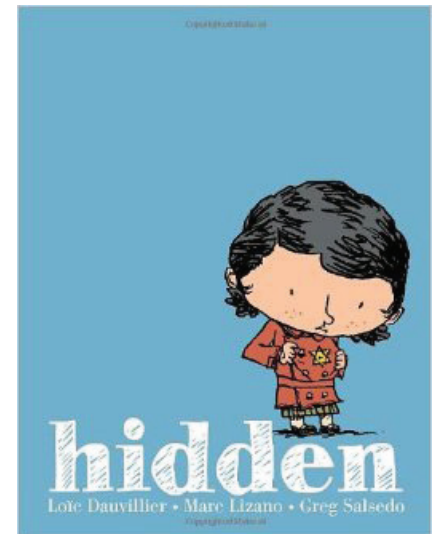
Living under Stalin in the Soviet Union, Sasha is in search of his father after he is taken away by the Communist police.
